CompTIA Security+ Certification Course

Effective August 2025

Description

This course prepares students for the CompTIA Security+ certification, a leading entry-level credential in cybersecurity. Students will learn essential skills in network security, threat detection, risk management, cryptography, identity management, and security protocols. Security+ emphasizes both hands-on and theoretical knowledge needed to secure IT systems.

Training cost:

\$2,000.00

Registration and payment are required at least 2 weeks prior to training.

Schedule:

The course runs for 7 weeks, totaling 168 contact hours, including 42 hours of in-person instruction (6 hours per week) and 126 hours of structured hands-on and self-paced learning.

Minimum Requirements:

There are no prerequisites for this course.

Course Materials & Supplies

All materials and supplies are included in the cost of training.

Certification

Upon completion of the training, students will be eligible to sit for CompTIA's Security+ certification exam.

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CompTIA A+ Certification Course

Effective August 2025

Description

This course prepares students for the CompTIA A+ certification, a globally recognized credential for entry-level IT professionals. Students will gain hands-on experience and technical knowledge in areas such as hardware, software, networking, mobile devices, operating systems, and IT troubleshooting. The A+ certification is often considered the first step toward a career in technical support and IT operations.

Training cost:

\$2,000.00

Registration and payment are required at least 2 weeks prior to training.

Schedule:

The course runs for 10 weeks, totaling 240 contact hours, including 60 hours of in-person instruction (6 hours per week) and 180 hours of structured hands-on and self-paced learning.

Minimum Requirements:

There are no prerequisites for this course.

Course Materials & Supplies

All materials and supplies are included in the cost of training.

Certification

Upon completion of the training, students will be eligible to sit for CompTIA's A+ certification exam.

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CompTIA Tech+ Certification Course

Effective August 2025

Description

This course prepares students for the CompTIA Tech+ certification, an industry-recognized credential that validates essential IT knowledge and digital literacy. The certification introduces learners to foundational IT concepts including hardware, software, networks, cybersecurity, databases, and troubleshooting.

Training cost:

\$500.00

Registration and payment are required at least 2 weeks prior to training.

Schedule:

The course runs for 2 weeks, with 6 hours of in-person instruction and approximately 6 hours of self-paced work each week for a total of 24 contact hours.

Minimum Requirements:

There are no prerequisites for this course.

Certification

Upon completion of the training, students will be eligible to sit for CompTIA's Tech+ certification exam.
