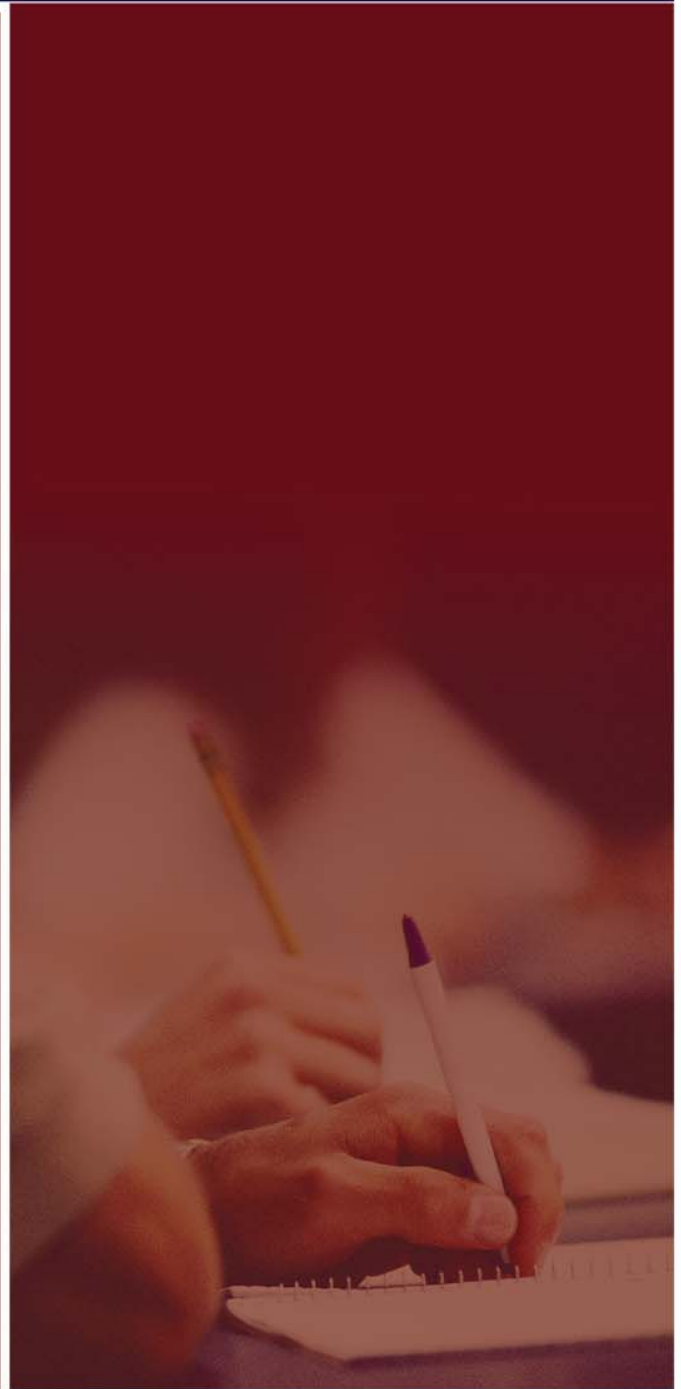

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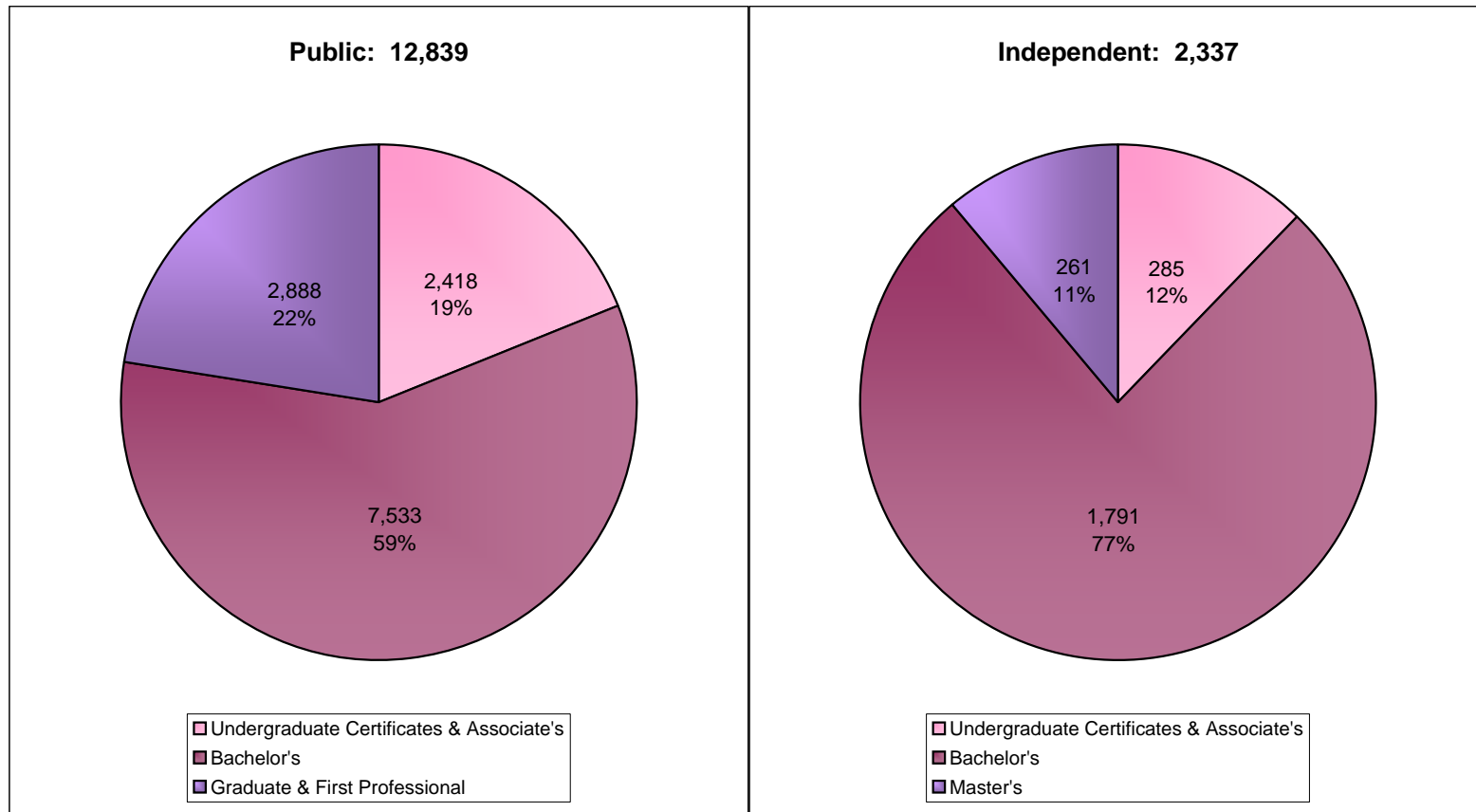
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## Certificates and Degrees Awarded by Level, 2002-03 Public and Independent Institutions



•Public higher education institutions awarded 12,839 certificates and degrees in 2002-03. Bachelor's degrees made up 7,533 or 59% of total awards; while 2,418 or 19% were at the certificate and associate's level. There were 2,888 graduate and first professional degrees awarded, making up 22% of total awards.

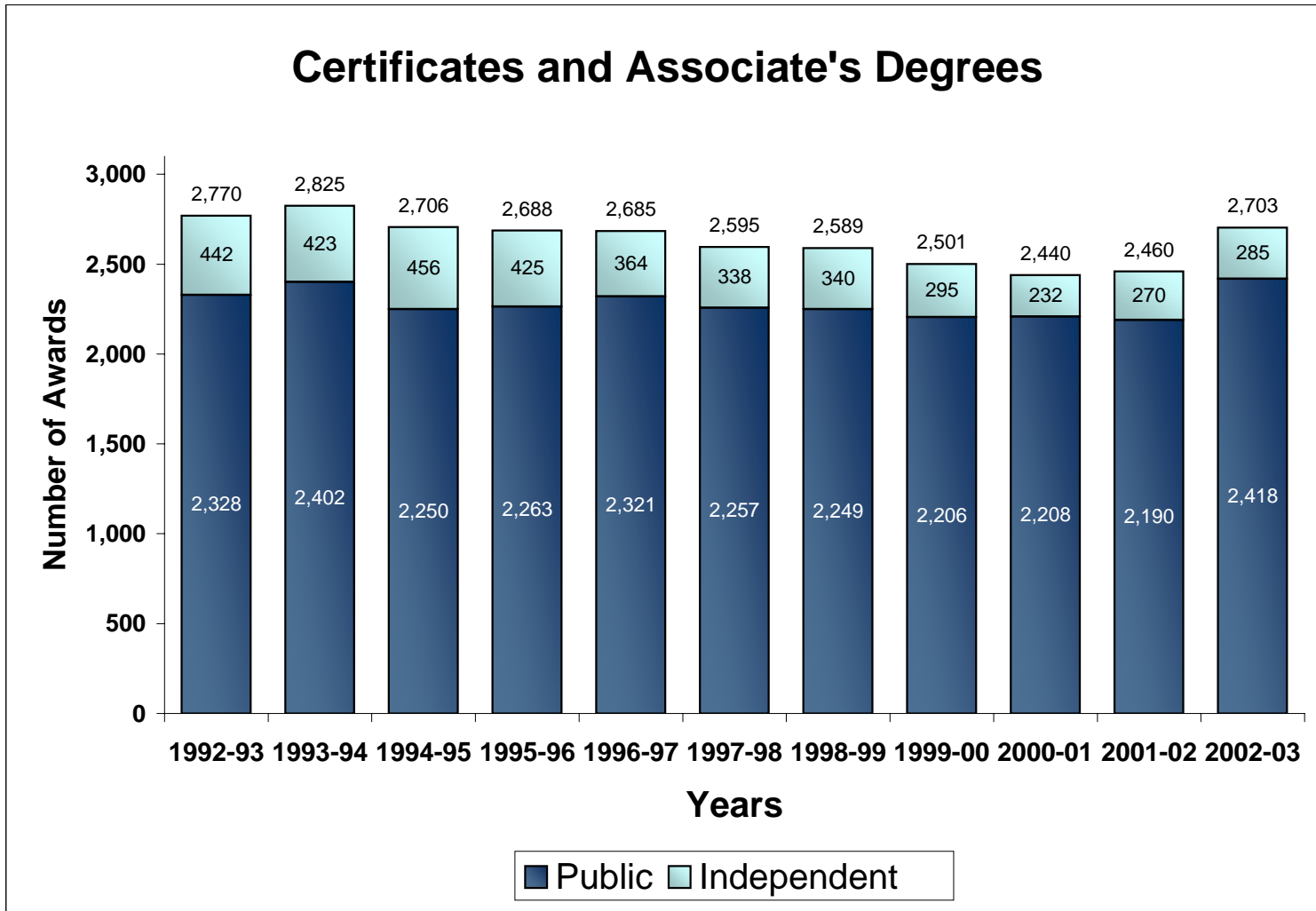
•Independent institutions awarded 2,337 certificates and degrees in 2002-03. Bachelor's degrees made up 1,791 or 77% of total awards; while 285 or 12% were at the certificate and associate's level. 261 or 11% of total awards were master's degrees.

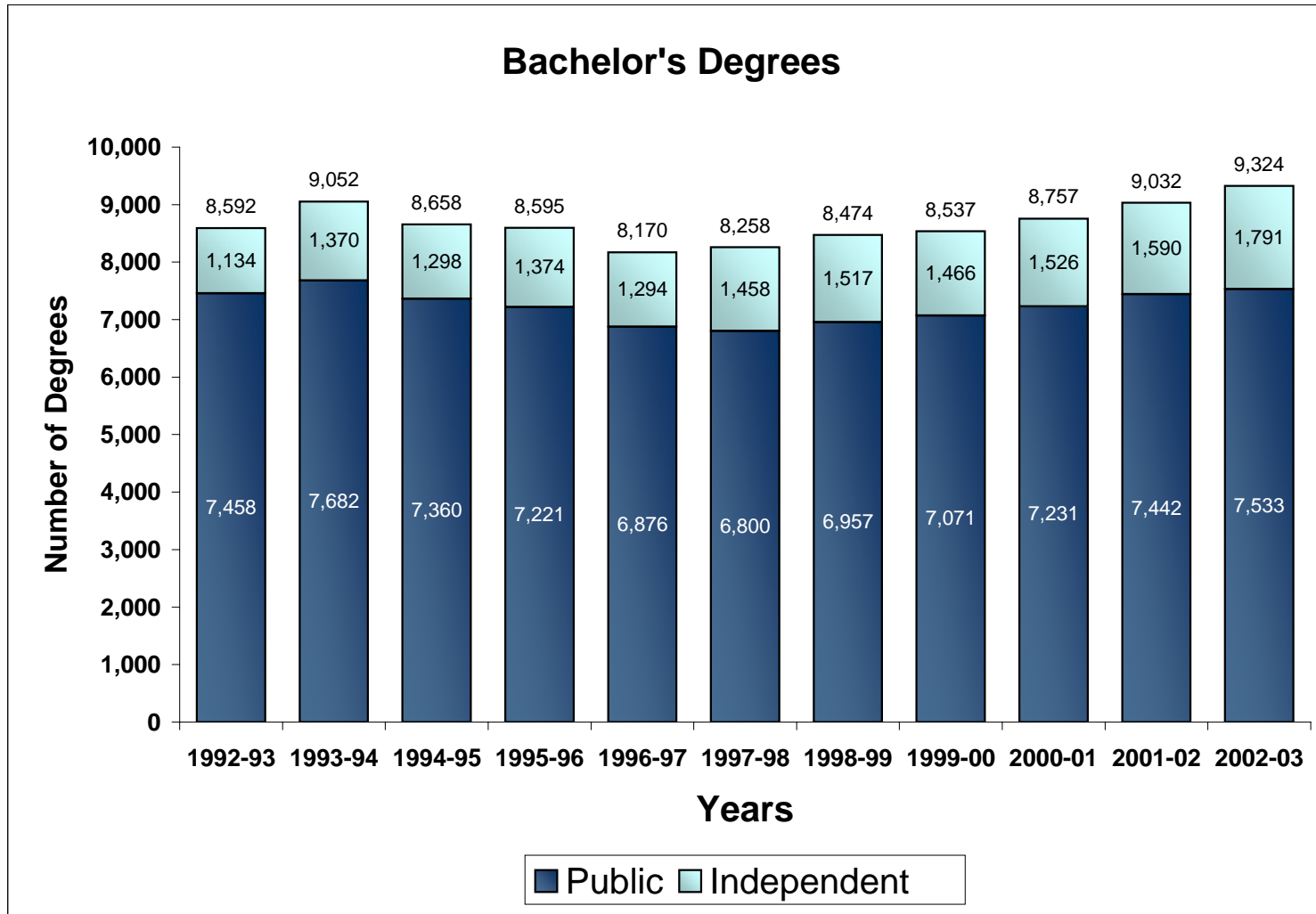

## Certificates and Associate's Degrees



•From 1992-93 to 2002-03, the number of certificates and associate's degrees awarded by public institutions rose 4% from 2,328 to 2,418. The current figure is the highest of the past decade.

•Over the same time period, independent institutions awarded 36% fewer certificates and associate's degrees, falling from 442 to 285; however, this appears to be the start of an upward swing at this level of award.



•From 1992-93 to 2002-03, the number of bachelor's degrees awarded by public institutions rose by 1% from 7,458 to 7,533. This represents a steady increase since 1997-98 and is the highest figure witnessed at this level during the past nine years.

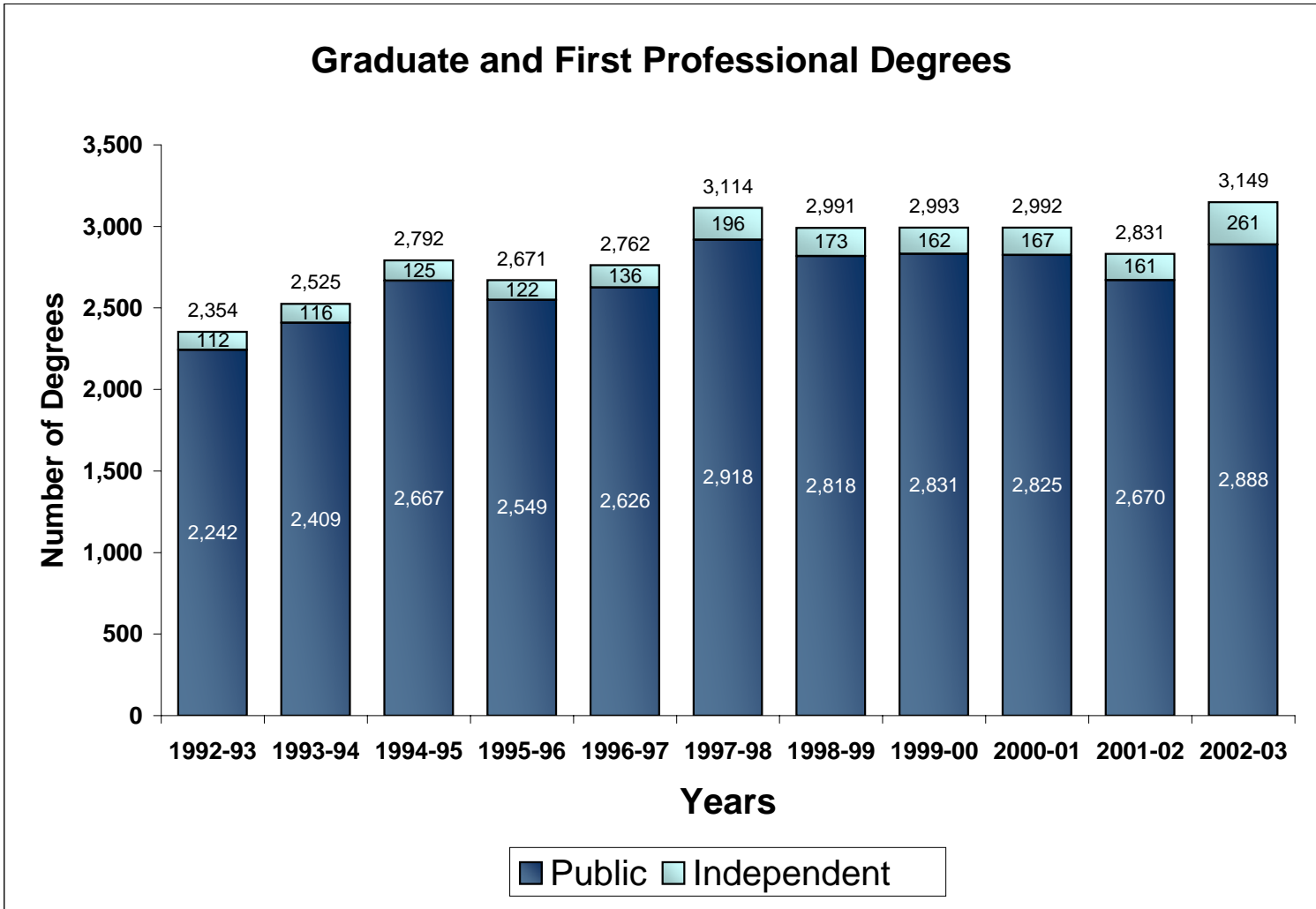
•Over the same time period, independent institutions awarded 58% more bachelor's degrees, increasing from 1,134 to 1,791. This is also a high point of the last decade for this sector of higher education.

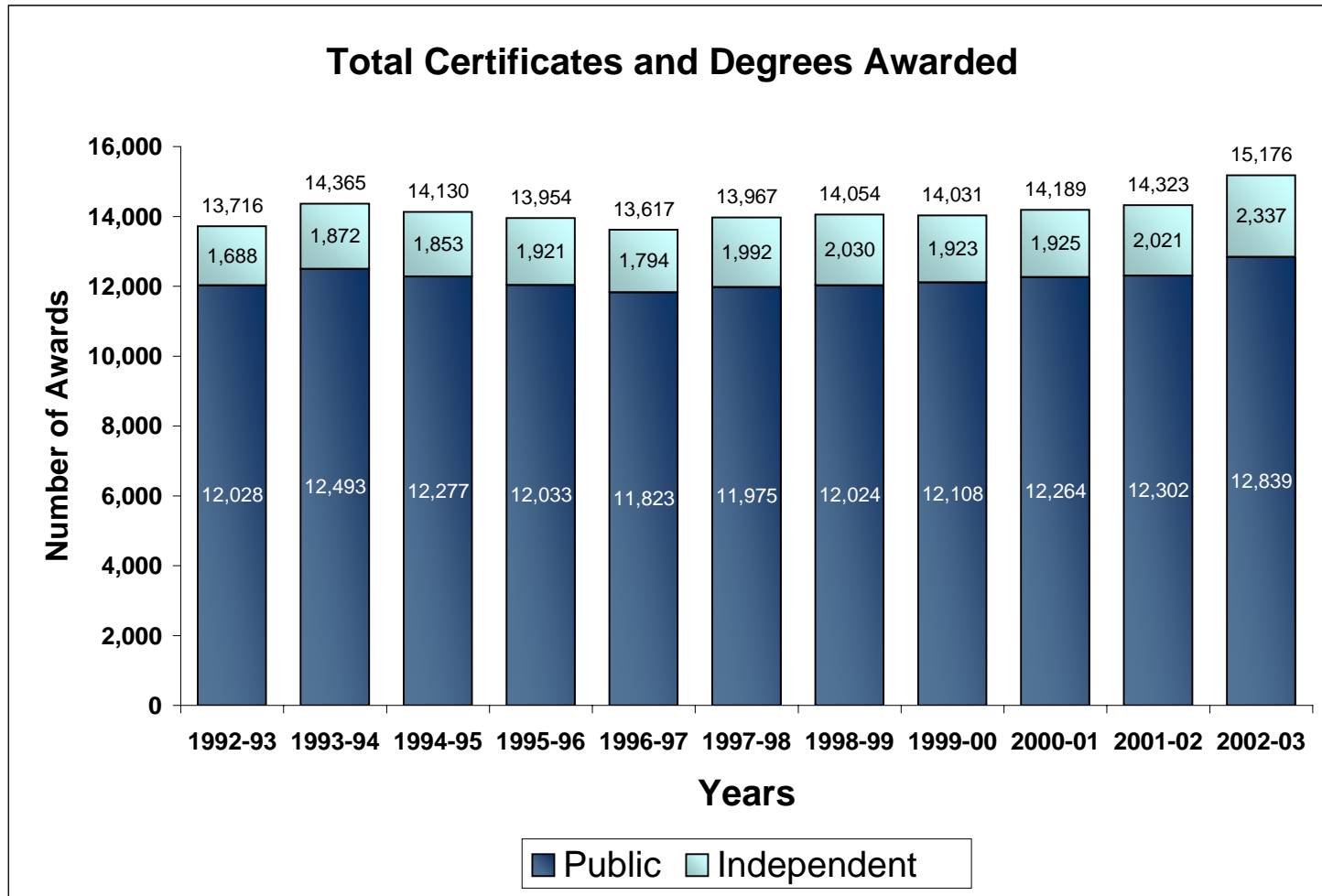


- From 1992-93 to 2002-03, graduate and first professional degrees awarded by public institutions increased by 29% from 2,242 to 2,888 representing a high for the decade.
- From 1992-93 to 2002-03, independent institutions increased their graduate degree awards 133% from 112 to 261, representing an all-time high for this decade.

•From 1992-93 to 2002-03, total certificates and degrees awarded by public institutions increased 7% from 12,028 to 12,839. Degree production has been slowly and steadily rising in recent years, and this past graduating class is the newly established peak of the decade.

•From 1992-93 to 2002-03, total certificates and degrees awarded by independent institutions rose 38% from 1,688 to 2,337; also establishing this year's graduating class as the peak of the decade for this sector of higher education.

Graduation rates are an extremely important measure of institutional success. Several other performance indicators, such as enrollments and first-to-second-year retention rates, directly affect this measure.

For baccalaureate institutions, the graduation rate is computed by taking a beginning cohort of first-time, full-time, degree-seeking students and measuring the number completing their degree within six years (150% of the normal program time). The statewide average for four-year public institutions is 43%. In 2003, the national average graduation rate for baccalaureate institutions was 54%. Increasing the graduation rates for West Virginia institutions to better match the national average is a clear and critical goal.

Graduation rates are an important measure of institutional success at community and technical colleges

For community and technical colleges, the graduation rate is computed by taking a beginning cohort of first-time, full-time, degree-seeking students and measuring the number completing their degree within three years (150% of the normal program time). The statewide average for CTC institutions is 12%. In 2003, the national average graduation rate for two-year institutions was 31%. Although increasing the graduation rates for West Virginia institutions to better match the national average is a clear and critical goal, it is important to note that CTC institutions often enroll non-traditional students who take longer than the traditional 150% timeframe for degree completion.

Although computing graduation rates within 150% of the degree timeframe is the national standard, it does not take into account the non-traditional component of the CTC student population. Many adult students enroll in a two-year program with the intent of completing a degree, but take more time to do so because of work or family obligations. By expanding the completion timeframe to five years, this table captures the additional graduates generated by each institution. In this case, a 12% statewide average expands to 16% when considering the longer timeframe.

This table expands the graduation perspective even further by tracking students who have graduated, regardless of degree type, across all West Virginia public institutions. This perspective recognizes the fact that many students start out pursuing a two-year degree, but then transfer to complete a four-year program at a baccalaureate institution. Under these constraints, the statewide graduation rate for students who begin working toward a Certificate or Associate's Degree rises to 25%.

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The tables in this report present certificates and degrees conferred during the 2002-03 academic year by the public and independent institutions of higher education in West Virginia, as well as trends in selected areas. The following are the definitions used.

## DEFINITIONS

- The National Center for Education Statistics' publication, *A Classification of Instructional Programs*, provided the background for the academic areas of study by which certificates and degrees were reported in this report.
- **Undergraduate Certificate** – A formal award certifying the satisfactory completion of an organized program of study at the postsecondary level (below the baccalaureate degree).
- **Associate's Degree** - A degree awarded upon completion of at least two, but fewer than four, years of college work.
- **Bachelor's Degree** - A degree granted upon completion of an educational program requiring at least four, but not more than five, years of academic work in the liberal arts, sciences, or professional fields.
- **First Professional Degree** - A degree which signifies the completion of the academic requirements for a selected profession, which is based on an educational program requiring at least two academic years of previous college work for entrance, and a total of at least six academic years of college work for completion. First professional degrees included in this report are the Doctor of Dental Surgery (D.D.S.), the Doctor of Medicine (M.D.), the Doctor of Osteopathy (D.O.), the Juris Doctor (J.D.), and the Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.).
- **Master's Degree** - A degree customarily granted upon successful completion of one (sometimes two) academic years of work in the liberal arts and sciences beyond the bachelor's degree. The master's degree in professional fields is an advanced degree beyond the first professional degree, but below the Ph.D.
- **Post-Master's Certificate** - A certificate awarded upon completion of an organized program of study beyond the master's degree, but does not meet the requirements of an academic degree at the doctoral level.
- **Doctoral Degree** - The highest academic degree in a given discipline or profession, based generally on three or more years of graduate work, satisfaction of a foreign language requirement, and completion of a special study resulting in a dissertation approved by a committee of the faculty.
